

# How to talk via an interpreter

## Tips for communicating in interpreted conversation.

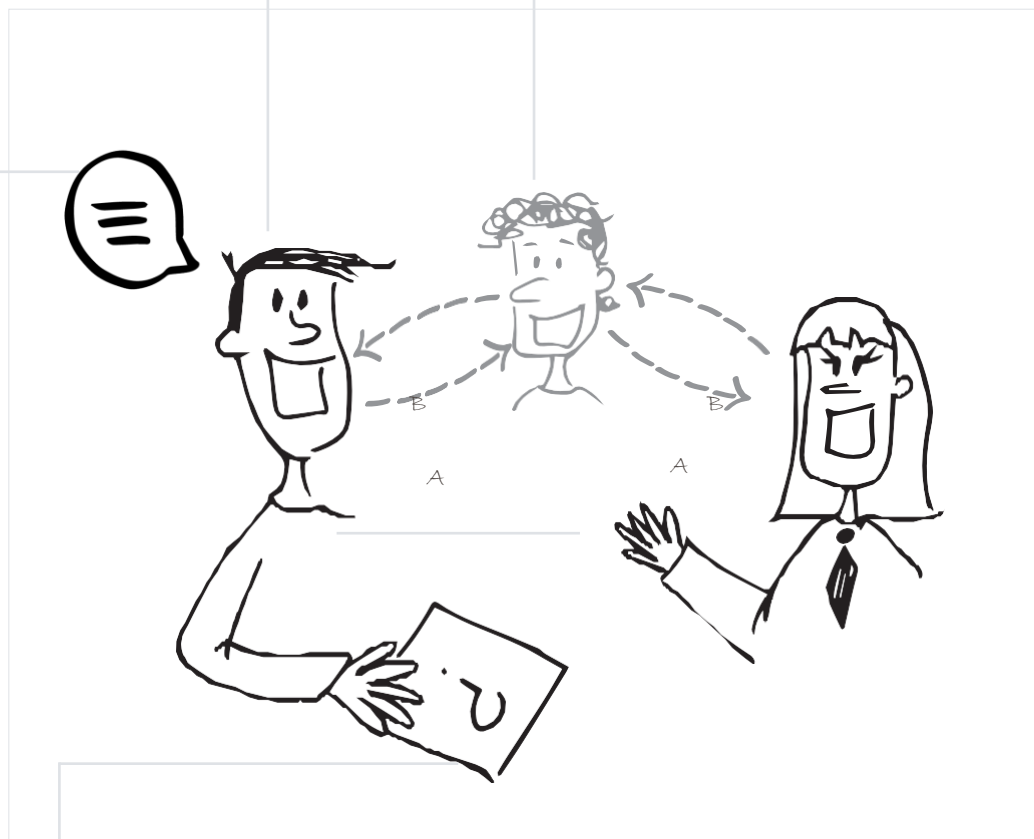
Before you start at a Danish workplace, the first dialogue with your employer will typically be aided by an interpreter who is present during the conversation.

Here are tips on how to participate in a conversation with an interpreter.

Keep eye contact with the one you are talking to (and not with the interpreter).

Remember that the interpreter is a helper in the conversation and not the person you conduct the conversation with.

Ask along the way if there is something you don't understand.



Prepare yourself before the interview, and write down questions so you remember them.

Repeat at last what you understand you that you have agreed. In this way you may correct any misunderstandings in time.
